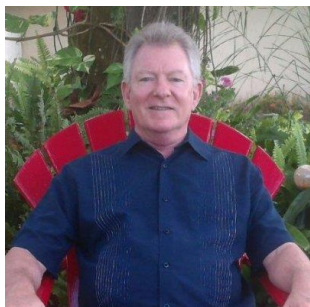


D. Robert Hoyle, Esq.
